Canadian horse tail hair has a tendency to be slightly thicker in diameter than other origins of white hair and is therefore coarser and stronger. It is ideal for double bass or cello, but has received a varied reception for use in violin…some applaud it, while others think it's too coarse.

This type of hair is picked, and damaged and short hairs are removed. It is more expensive due to its rarity.
